Purpose: Improve efficiency of your operation, build infrastructure to stabilize and enhance your operation, and/or grow customer base.



-Competitive

- -Up to \$10,000 total project budget
- -Application closes Monday, April 1st at 5 pm ET.
- -Awards anticipated to be announced in May, 2024.
- -Projects must be completed by December 1, 2024.



Eligible projects:


- -New on-farm projects only.
- -Tangible improvement projects (equipment, supplies, signage).

Examples from first round: on-farm orchard store, humane cattle chute, livestock watering system, apiary equipment, poultry de-boning/processing equipment; run-in shed for sheep.








- Successful applicants will receive an award letter to sign and return.

Veteran farmers with a plan to succeed and evidence that state funds will be well spent

Shovel ready projects likely to realize a timely return on investment

Well written proposals—complete & concise yet thorough; correct grammar/spelling, accurate budget



Write as if you're speaking to someone who does not necessarily do what you do.
